

STUDENT TRAVEL GRANT APPLICATION FORM

CONDITIONS:

- Applicants **MUST BE** affiliated with a Canadian institution and be CASCA members in good standing at the time of conference attendance, as well as an active participant in the meeting, i.e. delivering a paper, poster or other original contribution.
- The travel award is open to Masters and PhD students. Preference will be given to those who are well advanced in their program and who are presenting results or findings from their dissertation research.
- Applications must be accompanied by:
 - The abstract of your paper or panel submission.
 - CV (2-page maximum)
 - A completed application form (see below)
- Applicants who received a subsidy for the previous CASCA conference are not eligible this year.
- **Applications must be received by email no later than the deadlines on the website. Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered. Do not assume your message has been received unless it has been acknowledged.**
- Notice to successful applicants should be available by February 1st, giving sufficient time for applicants to make travel reservations and arrangements.

Awards of up to \$600 may be granted to an applicant. Approval of and the amount of the award will be calculated at the discretion of CASCA's Executive on the basis of travel distance, financial need, stage of program, scholarly merit and number of applicants.

- Funds will be disbursed at the conference, upon submission of original receipts, including proof of travel/ticket stub, a copy of student I.D. Please come prepared to provide copies.
